**George Crosfield**<sup>1</sup> was born in 1706, died in 1784, and was buried in FBG Park End, Preston Patrick, Cumbria.

Basic notes:

He worked as a Yeoman farmer in Low Park, Preston Richard.

George married **Jane Rowlandson**,<sup>1</sup> daughter of **James Rowlandson** and **Unknown**, in 1746. Jane was born in 1712 in Firth Hall, Cartmel, Cumbria, died in 1784, and was buried in FBG Park End, Preston Patrick, Cumbria. They had four children: **Simon, James, George** and **Joseph**.
